The Katrina disaster showed that government on all levels can be slow to react and respond. The Brigade intends to learn from Katrina and give our community the ability to respond quickly to a disaster by establishing the "Blue Tarp Fund". This special reserve fund will be available so that the Brigade can get needed emergency supplies early in a disaster to minimize suffering and property damage.
